The **Opportunities** to explore new **Possibilities** are everywhere. What will you explore?



Easy Banana Bread Recipe

This banana bread is one of the easiest recipes and it turns out perfectly every time!

Ingredients

- 3 medium bananas mashed
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- 1 egg
- 1 ½ cups flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ³/₄ cup sugar
- ½ cup chopped pecans (You can substitute your favorite nut instead or chocolate chips)

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350*F.
- 2. In a bowl mix together mashed bananas, mayo and egg. In a separate bowl combine flour, sugar, baking soda, salt, and pecans
- 3. Add flour mixture to wet mixture and stir just until combined. Note: The mixture will be very thick, do not over mix
- 4. Pour into a greased loaf pan. Bake 60-70 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean.
- 5. Remove from pan and allow to cool completely.
